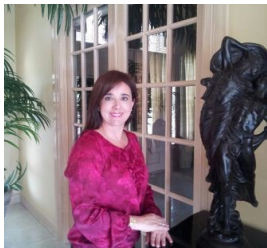
Robert A. Dyer

Irma Gonzalez

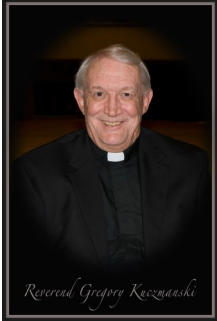
