

Policies for Juan Diego Academy Prom, Saturday, April 22, 2017

8:00 PM—12:00 AM

Juan Diego Academy Gymnasium

5208 South FM 494, Mission

1. Admission to the prom is by **ticket only, sold in advance. No tickets will be sold at the door.**
2. Students and their guests must arrive and sign in at the registration table no later than **9:00 PM.**
3. Juan Diego Academy students are entitled to bring **one** guest to the prom. Guests must be registered in advance upon purchase of ticket. Guests must show a valid high school student ID at the door along with the pre-paid prom ticket for admission. Seniors may bring a guest under the age of 21 showing a valid ID. **The behavior of guests is the responsibility of the student who invited them.**
4. Students who, on the last day of school before the date of prom (*Friday, April 21*), are absent, half day absent, or sent home early from school may not attend the prom (**this includes their invited guest**). Exceptions may be made by the Principal under certain circumstances (e.g. early dismissal for a doctor's appointment.)
5. Students may not be readmitted once they leave. Students will sign out upon leaving the prom early and verify transportation with the designated faculty member. **The student's guest must leave with the student.**
6. Students may not leave the designated area for the prom while in attendance. Limited exceptions may be made if the student is supervised by a faculty member of Juan Diego Academy.
7. Possession of drugs/alcohol at prom or use of drugs/alcohol prior to attending prom is a serious violation of school policy. Students who violate this policy can expect severe disciplinary consequences.
8. Students are to dress appropriately for prom. The dress code for this prom is: **formal** (*young men should be dressed in tuxedo, two or three-piece suit, or matching sport coat, slacks, & tie. Appropriate dress shoes and socks must be worn. Young ladies should be dressed in formal gown/evening dress of tea length or longer (hem must be at or below the knee). Sleeveless gowns/gowns with straps are permitted provided the back of the dress is not inappropriately revealing. No see-through dresses or dresses with cutouts are permitted.* The judgment of the administration in regards to proper dress **is final** at prom. Students who are in violation of proper dress for this occasion will be asked to leave.
9. Policies regarding inappropriate dress/appearance are in effect at all school functions—whether on or off campus.
10. Prior to reservation-only dances, dance policies will be reviewed with both students and parents and published in the weekly *E-News* prior to the date of the dance.
